

School Uniform

Children are expected to wear school uniform consisting of:

- Polo shirt with embroidered logo on left breast, in choice of heather grey or white.
- Crew neck raglan sweatshirt with embroidered logo on left breast, in choice of navy, burgundy or black; or zip-front hooded sweatshirt with embroidered logo on left breast, in choice of navy or black.
- Plain black or grey trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore.
- Black school shoes - may include plain black trainers. Sensible sandals may be worn in summer. (No high heels, crocs or flip flops.)

As an alternative, children may wear any plain white or grey polo shirt with a plain black, navy or burgundy sweatshirt: no visible logos or stripes. In summer, girls may wear a standard red or blue gingham school dress with navy blue or burgundy cardigan.

- In addition a reversible fleece / showerproof jacket is available. This has reflective strips for visibility, and the logo embroidered on the back of both fleece and showerproof sides. It is available in choice of navy, burgundy or black.

PE and Games

- Team T-shirts, with a printed logo on the left breast, in the team colours of blue (Ravens), yellow (Kestrels), red (Eagles) and green (Hawks). Children are placed in a team on entry to the school, so should wear the appropriate coloured t-shirt. Alternatively, plain coloured t-shirts are acceptable.
- Plain black PE shorts – not Bermuda shorts, Skate shorts, $\frac{3}{4}$ length shorts.

PE indoors is usually done in bare feet. For outdoor Games, daps or trainers should be worn.

In cold weather, children may wear jogging bottoms and sweatshirts for outdoor Games.

For swimming, girls must wear a one piece swimming costume and boys must wear trunks, not shorts. Children are encouraged to wear a swimming cap. These can be provided by the pool.

Jewellery and Make Up

- Make up, including nail varnish, should not be worn for school under any circumstances.
- Jewellery should not be worn, with the following exceptions:
 - A single stud earring in each ear, which must be removed or taped over for PE, Games and Swimming lessons
 - A bracelet or necklace which has religious significance, subject to a letter from parents explaining the importance of said item to their faith.
