WHO ARE THE BEST BAKERS IN EACH CLASS?

INFORMATION AND RULES

Each class will organise its own Bake-Off Day during Term 4.

Children will make cupcakes at home, using the recipe provided and decorated with a Comic Relief or Red Nose theme. (You may alter the recipe to suit your food allergy or dietary preferences, and may then label the cakes accordingly as being, for example, "Free From..." Or "Suitable for vegans" for the purposes of the cake sale.)

We trust bakers to have limited grown-up guidance, but parents must help when using the oven.

On the day of the class Bake-Off, children will bring 6 cupcakes to school, to their classroom, where they will be judged.

All cakes will then be sold at the end of the day, in the Dining Hall.

It costs 50p to enter the competition. Cakes will be sold for minimum 50p each. All proceeds will be given to Comic Relief.

Judging

Cakes will be judged for Cake Quality (taste and consistency) and Beautiful Appearance (design and execution).

There will be a winner in each class. Certificates will be presented in Assembly and photos of the winning cakes will be posted on the website.

The judges will choose the three best class winners in Years 5 and 6 to form a team to represent HJS at an inter-school Year 5/6 Bake-Off which is being held on 12th March at Christchurch Primary School, one of our NW24 partner schools.
