Reading

By the end of Year 4 children should be able to

Word Reading – Decoding

Apply their growing knowledge of root words, prefixes and suffixes (etymology and morphology) to read aloud.

Understand the meaning of words in context.

Range of Reading

Read, listen to and discuss a range of age appropriate texts and express opinions, justifying them by reference to the text.

Understanding

Understand what they read, in books they can read independently, by identifying main ideas drawn from more than one paragraph and summarising these.

Inference

Infer characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions, and justify inferences with evidence.

Information retrieval

Retrieve and record information from texts, extracting explicit facts.
