


Henleaze Junior School is very unlikely to close in the event of snowfall. Most of our staff live within walking distance, and we have established that we could probably provide enough teachers to cover for any who might find it difficult to get in to work.

In the event of snow, the Headteacher, Business Manager and Caretaker will all speak to each other early in the morning to check that the premises are safe - pathways cleared and heating working - before making any decision about school closure. If for any reason it looks like we cannot open, we will make a decision by 7:30 am and publish that decision by 8:00 am.



If we decide to close the school, we will:

•Put a notice on the Home Page of the website.

•Inform Bristol City Council, who will inform BBC Radio Bristol.

•Send a text message and email via School Comms to all parents who have provided email addresses and mobile phone numbers (as long as we are able to access the school's computer network)

If parents pick up a message that the school is closed, we encourage them to call their friends and pass the message on.

If we do not do any of these things, then the school will be open!
