Admissions Criteria

- Academies, Faith Schools etc. can set their own
 Admissions Criteria
- Some use Catchment Areas
- Some prioritise FSM recipients
- Some have Social/Medical grounds
- Others have faith criteria
- Majority of schools still use the Local Authority's criteria
- Pupils with an EHCP need to follow a different process via the SEN Team



Trading with Schools

1. Children in care or previously in care

- Children in care co-ordinated by LA
- Definition of previously in care:

'Children who were looked after but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a residence order or special guardianship order)'



Trading with Schools

2. Siblings

 Brother, sister, half brother or sister, step brother or sister or child of parent/carer's partner where the child for whom the place is sought is living in the same family unit at the same address as that sibling.

Only applies when the sibling is in attendance



Trading with Schools

3. Geography

- APAs, Parish Boundaries
- Home to school distance
- As the crow flies
- Home address is where the child spends the majority of the time
- May need to request evidence eg. tenancy agreement or letter from solicitor

Case Study

- Jimmy lives at 1 Henleaze Avenue
- Parents check 'My Neighbourhood' and they live in Bristol Free and Redland Green's Area
- Parent visits all the schools and does a lot of research
- Lives very close to Redland Green but would prefer Bristol Cathedral Choir because Mum works next door and best friend will be going there as has a sibling.



Scenario 1

- "I really want Bristol Cathedral Choir School. I feel it is the perfect school for Jimmy. I am going to put it down as my one and only preference so that the council can't fob me off with something else"
- 1st Pref Bristol Cathedral Choir
- 2nd Pref None
- 3rd Pref None



Trading with Schools

Scenario 1 - Outcome

- Jimmy's application is considered under BCCS random allocation. A draw takes place and Jimmy's name is drawn 897th. A place cannot be offered.
- No other schools are listed as preferences
- At the end of the process Jim looks at a list of all those children yet to be offered a school, puts them on a map and offers them the nearest school with a place available which is 6km away.



Scenario 2

- "I really want Bristol Cathedral Choir School. I feel it is the perfect school for Jimmy. I am going to put it down as my 1st preference. I realise that there is a possibility that I may not get it, so I will add Redland Green as my 2nd preference and Bristol Free as my 3rd.
- 1st Pref Bristol Cathedral Choir
- 2nd Pref Redland Green
- 3rd Pref Bristol Free



Trading with Schools

Scenario 2 - Outcome

- Jimmy's application is considered under BCCS random allocation. A draw takes place and Jimmy's name is drawn 523rd. A place cannot be offered.
- Jimmy qualifies for a place at Redland Green, the fact that it is a 2nd preference makes no difference. His 2nd preference ranks higher than a 1st preference who lives further away. He also qualifies for Bristol Free but this is ignored because we can offer RGS which is a higher preference
- Jimmy can still go on a waiting list for BCCS or appeal and the place at Redland Green will be saved while he waits.
